Driver Education at Whitko Jr/Sr High School

- 1. Students must be **15** years old to begin the class.
- Students are required to complete **30 hours** of classroom (online or traditional) and **6 hours** of driving with an instructor. Students who complete both requirements may apply for their license at 16 years and 90 days old. Students who do not take a driver education course must wait until they are 16 years and 270 days old to apply for their license.
- 3. Whitko will offer two sessions of the traditional classroom January 13- January 31, 2025 and June 2-13, 2025.

Online Course Option (Driving Only with Whitko Instructor)

- 1. Search the web at "mybmv.in.gov", click on permits, then Driver Education, then scroll down to Licensed Driver Training schools and choose an online provider.
- 2. Once a student completes and passes an online course, he/she will receive a certificate showing completion.
- 3. Students bring the certificate of completion, the attached application with the "Driving Only" option marked and either partial or full payment to the Whitko Jr/Sr High School office.
- 4. The student will receive a CDE (Certificate of Driver Education enrollment) form from a school official. This document along with the online course certificate of completion must be taken to the BMV to obtain the Learner's Permit. (See getting your Learner's Permit below)

Traditional Classroom Option

- 1. To enroll in the traditional classroom, complete the registration form on page two. Return the form along with payment to Whitko Jr/Sr High School.
- Traditional classroom students will receive a CDE form from the classroom instructor in the first few days of class. The CDE must be taken to the BMV to obtain a Learner's Permit. (See getting a Learner's Permit below)

Getting a Learner's Permit

- 1. Complete the classroom requirements. Students must earn a B- or better to pass the class.
- 2. Take the following forms to the BMV:
 - a. CDE Form issued by school official
 - b. Social Security Card
 - c. Birth Certificate
 - d. 2 documents proving residency (a list of approved documents is available)
- 3. Pass a vision test and a written test at the BMV.
- 4. Once a permit is obtained, students will work with one of Whitko's instructors to schedule drive times.
- 5. Students must hold a permit for at least 180 days before getting their license.

Cost of Driver Education

- 1. The fee for the traditional classroom and driving is \$275.00 for Whitko students & \$300.00 for other students.
- 2. The fee for Driving Only (students taking an online course) is \$225.00 for Whitko students & \$250.00 for other students. The cost of the online course is your responsibility and depends on your choice of provider.
- 3. Fees may be paid in full or in two installments. All fees should be paid in full before the conclusion of the student's driving portion with the instructor. Student's completion certificate will not be signed until all fees are paid in full.

4. Make checks payable to Whitko Jr/Sr High School.
